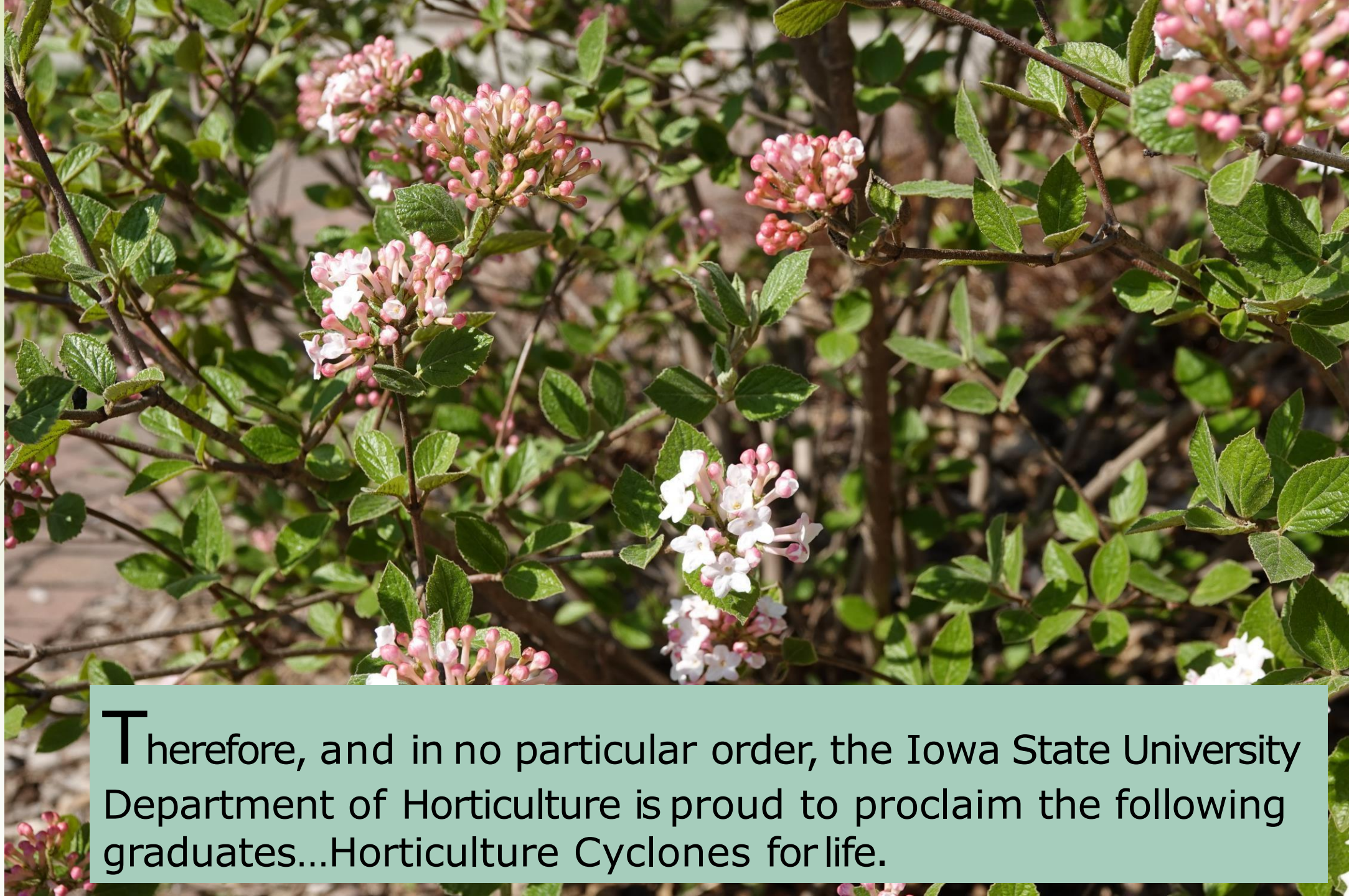

Agronomy.

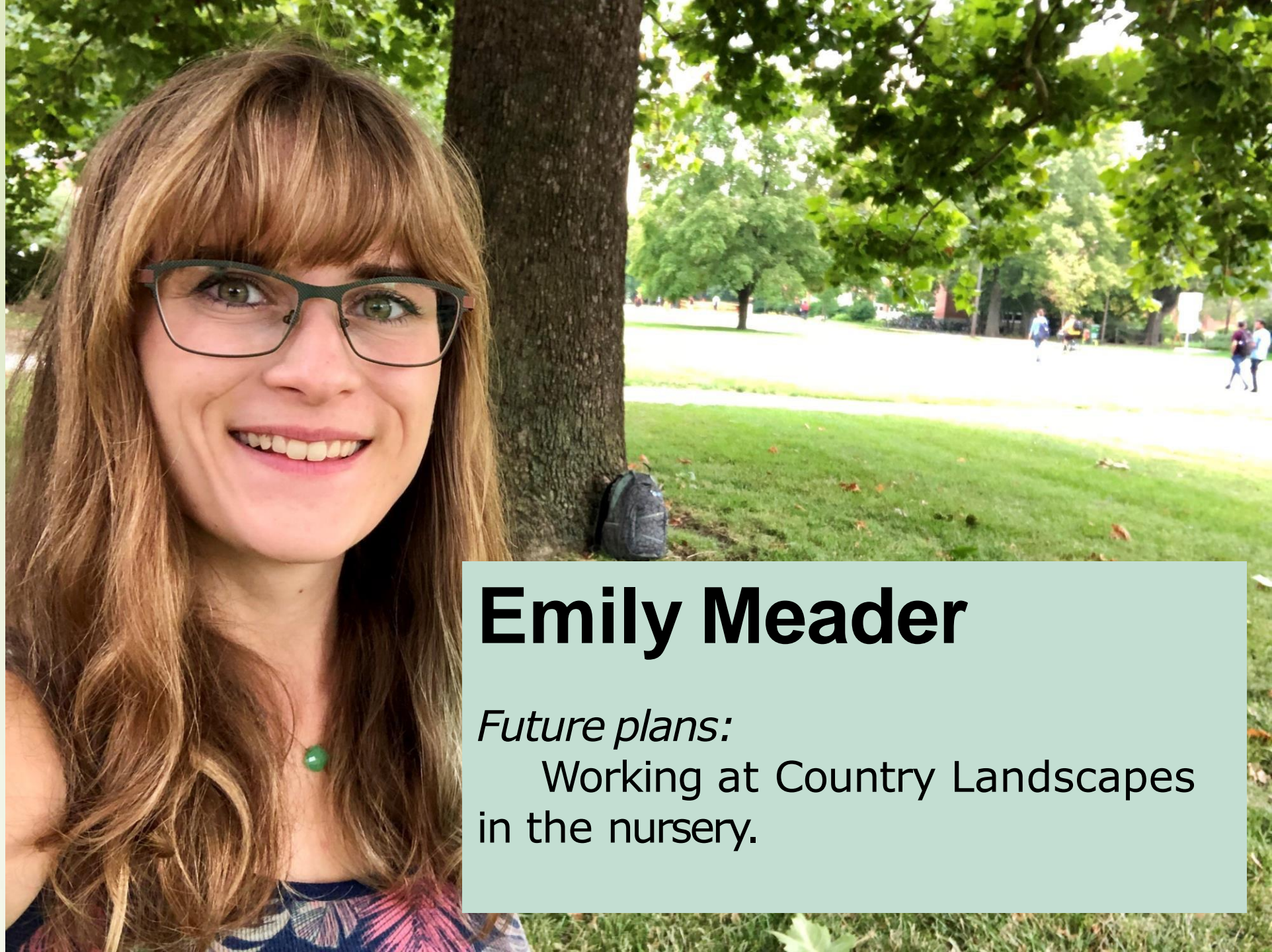

Currently applying to a few places and am hoping to hear back from them soon.

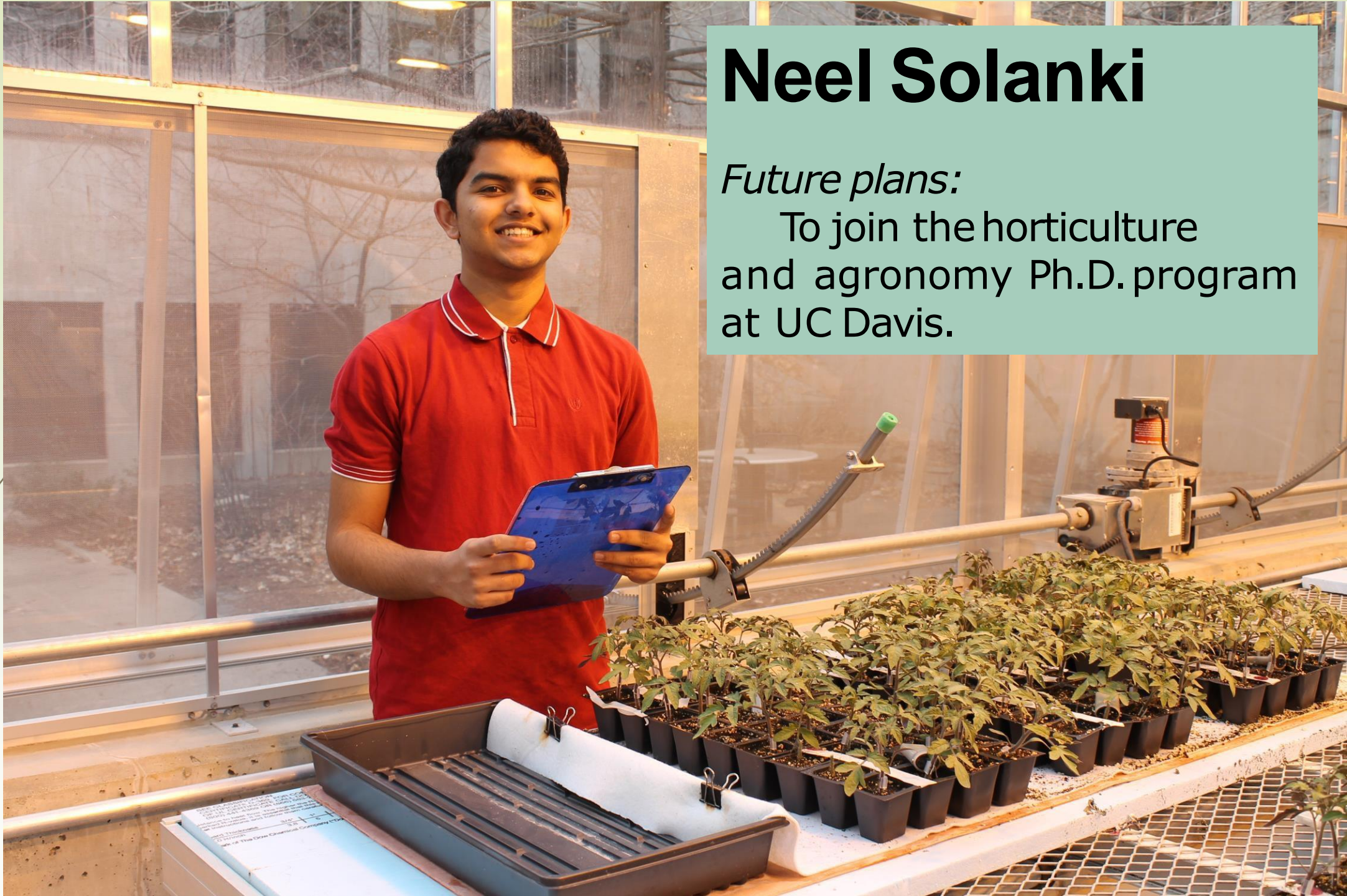

Starting at Country Landscapes (Ames, IA) as a design/sales assistant helping designers with their workload of customer service, designing, and general communications.




